Parent Link is independent and impartial

Parent Link is part of East Sussex County Council. We operate at arms length from all services and schools.

We give fully independent and impartial information and advice to parents and carers.

The Parent Link Steering Group, which includes parents, makes sure that Parent Link is run in the right way.

Parent Link is confidential

We will keep information about you and your child confidential and secure. We will not share information with anyone outside Parent Link unless you want us to.

We would only share personal information without your consent in very exceptional circumstances, for example, if we felt a child was at risk of significant harm.

We will follow East Sussex County Council's Confidentiality and Information Sharing guidelines, and the requirements of the Data Protection Act.

Parent Link is a parent partnership service

We follow guidance in the SEN Code of Practice and are members of the National Parent Partnership Network.
