Dear parents and carers,

I hope you have had productive and restful summer holidays. I would just like to send a quick reminder about uniform and equipment expectations before the new term starts:

Uniform

All students, Year 7 – 11, should be in the following;

- 1) Black smart shoes -No trainers, vans or ankle boots.
- 2) School trousers or the school skirt - **No jeans or skinny trousers. All skirts to or just above the knee.**

Year 7 - 10

- 1) Students wearing a skirt from Year 7-10 should all be in a black pleated skirt.
All skirts to or just above the knee.
- 2) Students wearing trousers should be in black tailored trousers. **No jeans or skinny trousers.**
- 3) Blazers are compulsory for all students in Years 7-10.
- 4) The school jumper from Years 7-10 is a black V-neck jumper (where their tie is visible at the top).
The old school jumper should not be worn.

Year 11

Students have the option of wearing the old uniform or the new uniform. If students choose to wear a shirt and tie, the shirt must be tucked in.

Make Up

- 1) No make up for Year 7 and 8 students.
- 2) Discreet make up is allowed Year 9 – 11.



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Equipment

All students should be fully equipped for school at all times. This means they should have their golden 5:

Box file
Pen
Pencil
Ruler
Reading book

Students should also have a scientific calculator on those days they have maths. It is advised, but not compulsory, that students also carry the following items:

**Spare equipment so that they are prepared if their pen breaks.
A rubber and sharpener**

Some students may also find it useful to carry a small notebook or diary with them to keep a record of any homework set or important dates.
