Create Music Summer School

Create Music teachers have been promoting courses to their pupils, but please note that all pupils in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex are able to take part, with courses running in Brighton, Lewes and Eastbourne this year and there are courses suitable for all ages, with some of their music tech courses - including Composing and Scoring for Film - and our Rock and Pop courses being tailored to older students.

There are still places available. All courses are taught by experienced Create Music teachers, offering an opportunity to develop musical skills over a range of courses that all lead to a celebration performance. They also offer a bursary scheme for families on low incomes.



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Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) for Summer 2025 - Message from the HAF Team

The summer holidays are approaching and Holiday food and fun! is coming back!

Families can find out what's available and book a place on the HAF booking website.

This DfE funded programme offers a range of exciting activities for all school-aged young people who receive benefits-related free school meals, up to and including Year 11. Parents can check if they qualify by reading the East Sussex County Council website Free school meals page.

All sessions include a healthy meal and are free to eligible young people. There is a great range of clubs spread across multiple venues in East Sussex. Activities include sport, art, theatre, forest school, animation, music, computer coding and crafts.

A small number of places will also be available to children and young people who:

- Disabled or special educational needs, including those with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)
- Children in Need (CiN)
- Referred to Children and Adolescent Mental Health Services (CAMHS)
- Young Carers
- Have a disabled sibling
- Children on a Child Protection Plan (CP) and Looked After Children (LAC)
- Refugee groups

At Easter over 2,500 young people attended HAF provision,1,020 of whom were secondary-aged. We received some amazing feedback from families.

Here's a sample of what they said:

Parent/ carer comments:

- My daughter thoroughly enjoyed the wide range of activities on offer and found the staff caring and fun.
- This was amazing! My son really enjoyed the two days he was able to attend and was supported
 by the team to try new activities and to persevere when he found them difficult. He came away
 from rock climbing really proud of what he had achieved.
- The leaders were fantastic. J had great fun and expanded his nature knowledge

Young people's comments:

- I get to meet new people and have some space.
- It's so fun! I want to come again!
- I got to express who I am.
