## **FAO Y7 Parents/Carers - PCS 'Ten for Success'**

At PCS, we make it clear to all of our students that in order to be a successful student they need to be ready to learn. This includes having all of the correct equipment for the school day.

Whilst the majority of our students do come to school fully prepared, we are seeing an increasing number of students arriving at school without even the basics of a pen and pencil.

To support all of our students, we are making some positive changes to our equipment expectations.

After the Easter break we will be expecting all of our year 7 students to come to school with their **Ten for Success**. This comprises of:

- 1 x pencil case
- 1 x purple pen
- 2 x black pens
- 1 pencil
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 ruler
- 1 rubber
- 1 glue stick

Plus a reading book.

All of these items can be readily and cheaply purchased from any stationery shop or online, however to make things easier we are offering a 'PCS Bundle' for **£2.50** which includes all of the stationery. If your child does not have a reading book, we have a well stocked Library, should your child require one, this is open everyday. We are also looking at organising a book swap early into next term.

We will be placing orders on **Thursday 3 April**, so please make payment on ParentPay if you wish to purchase a 'PCS Bundle' for your child. Those who have placed an order will be notified in the first week back when their child can collect the bundle.

We will be expecting every year 7 to be fully equipped on the first day back after the break - with all of their equipment in a school bag which is big enough to hold an A4 exercise book. At the end of term 5 we shall be offering a reward event to all those students who show these key organisational skills. More details about this will be shared with the students in assembly.

We will be rolling out this expectation across the rest of KS3 in term 6. Following on from this, the rest of the school will then also be expected to have their PCS Ten for Success at all times.

### **Food Hall - Staggered Sitings**

Over the next term, we will be slightly staggering when year groups can get food from the Food Hall on some of the sittings.
