Dear PCS Families

Uniform: This is looking really strong. Thank you for your support as it really makes a difference. We have been conducting more Student Voice this term, especially following our drive on uniform and students have said that they have found the fact that we have the same expectations for all, helps them feel like things are fair. They also understand why we sometimes make reasonable adjustments. It's really important to us that students have an opportunity to explore how they feel about our policies. We still have a no jewellery policy and so no new piercings should appear over the holiday. Mobile phones: Our stance on this related to safeguarding and wellbeing concerns. Mobile phones are not permitted to be used during the school day. Phones seen being used will be confiscated and taken to Reception. Consistent misuse will result in students having to hand their phone in before entering the school. Please do not contact your child on their mobile during school hours. If you need to get a message to them you can do that via our Reception team.
