Please be reminded that some of our students suffer with asthma symptoms which can be triggered by spray deodorants and perfumes. Asthma is a chronic lung disease that causes a tightening of the airways, making it hard to breathe: coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath and chest tightness. We understand that our students want to feel fresh throughout the day; in hot weather and especially after PE, but they should not be carrying sprays with them, instead they should use alternatives (e.g. wipes and roll ons). If students are found to be using sprays, especially in confined spaces, sanctions will be put in place.

- dinner accounts can be topped up via ParentPay (if you are having difficulties accessing ParentPay, please email us at pcs-enquiries@swale.at)
- in your account settings a notification can be set up to alert you as to when your child's ParentPay account balance is low
- students with biometric (fingerprint) consent can check their account balance daily using our balance checker, located by our Student Support Desk at Reception
- students entitled to Free School Meals should budget their allowance across break and lunch (if their entire allowance is spent at morning break time, no more purchases can be made at lunch)
- if students' accounts cannot be topped up for the following day in order to make a purchase in the Food Hall, they should bring a packed lunch instead
