Reminder - Food Hall, Topping Up Accounts

Please note that if students do not have money in their dinner accounts they will not be served by staff in the Food Hall.

We would like to remind parents/carers of the following:

- dinner accounts can be topped up via ParentPay (if you are having difficulties accessing ParentPay, please email us at pcs-enquiries@swale.at)
- in your account settings a notification can be set up to alert you as to when your child's ParentPay account balance is low
- students with biometric (fingerprint) consent can check their account balance daily using our balance checker, located by our Student Support Desk at Reception
- students entitled to Free School Meals should budget their allowance across break and lunch (if their entire allowance is spent at morning break time, no more purchases can be made at lunch)
- if students' accounts cannot be topped up for the following day in order to make a purchase in the Food Hall, they should bring a packed lunch instead

If your child purchases their lunch from the Food Hall, please ensure their accounts are topped up the day before as balances in accounts do not update instantly.

Fireworks - Staying Safe - Message from East Sussex Fire & Rescue Service

For Key Stage 3 & 4 students the main safety messages are:

- *Never put fireworks in your pocket or throw them*
- *When you are watching fireworks, always stand well back*
- *Never go near a firework when it has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off, it could still explode*
- *Never give sparklers to a child under five*
- *Keep pets indoors*

Safety Messages for Parents/Carers Setting Off Fireworks

- *Only buy fireworks marked with the British Standard mark, BS7114*
- *Don't drink alcohol if setting off fireworks*
- *Keep fireworks in a closed metal box*
- *Follow the instructions on each firework by torchlight, not a naked flame*
- *Fireworks should be lit at arm's length, using a taper*
- *Always supervise children around fireworks*
- *Keep pets indoors*

What does the law say?

The Fireworks Regulations 2004 make it an offence to:

- *Sell fireworks to people under 18 years of age*
- *Possessing fireworks in a public place, if you are under 18 years of age*
- *Throw a firework in the street or public place*
- *Don't let off noisy fireworks after 11.00pm*

'Show Racism the Red Card' - Raising Awareness, Friday 17 October

On Friday 17 October PCS will take part in 'Show Racism the Red Card'. Students can wear their PE tops or their red PCS Run tops instead of their shirts/ties and blazer (normal bottom half).

It will be an opportunity for students to make donations, sell cakes and the money raised will be put towards an educational visit from external people to deliver sessions to tackle racism.

Mr Myson and Ms Poulton will be running a creative writing workshop on Monday 13 October and the poems showing solidarity and celebrating diversity will be delivered to the leader of the Muslim community.

The focus is about raising awareness and noticing when comments are made. There are clear sanctions in place for students being racists, we need to notice who is doing this so we can educate them.

Rationale for [Peacehaven Community School Uniform Consultation](#)

At Peacehaven Community School, our values of Aspire, Believe, Contribute, and Achieve underpin everything we do. Our school uniform is an important part of how these values are lived out in daily life. We are undertaking a consultation on our school uniform to ensure it continues to serve our community well and reflects both our ethos and the needs of our families.

A consistent school uniform provides a sense of belonging, identity, and connection for all students. It unites us as a community, helping students feel part of something bigger than themselves, and reinforces pride in being a member of Peacehaven Community School. Wearing the same uniform helps to create a shared identity that reflects our values and our commitment to being Polite, Committed, and Safe.

We also recognise the need to balance this sense of identity with the realities of the cost of living. Affordability is a key concern for many families, and we are committed to ensuring that our uniform policy is fair, accessible, and does not place unnecessary financial burdens on parents and carers. In line with the UK government's guidance on school uniform affordability, we are reviewing the number and cost of branded items required, so that our policy offers value for money while maintaining a smart and distinctive appearance.

Importantly, we believe that school uniform plays a central role in promoting equality. It helps to level the playing field so that young people are not judged on what they wear, or what they and their families can afford, but instead on their actions, words, and contributions to the school community. In this way, uniform supports inclusion, reduces peer pressure, and fosters respect between students.
