#### **Head Lice Advice**

There has been a reported case of head lice which can easily spread with close contact - although they do not pose a serious risk, they can be uncomfortable and require prompt treatment with over the counter products available from pharmacies.

Please check or get your child to check their hair and scalp regularly for any signs of head lice: small white eggs (nits) attached to the hair shaft as well as live lice.

To prevent spreading head lice, encourage your child to avoid sharing personal items such as hats, combs, and hair accessories - regularly wash bedding and clothing in hot water.

There will be a literary-spot treasure hunt! Students will be expected to make their own way to and from Brighton for this event. They will meet with PCS staff in the Town Centre.







#### What Next?


Each student will have a Google form in their PDI Google Classroom. Every student in years 7, 8 and 9 must fill this in.







