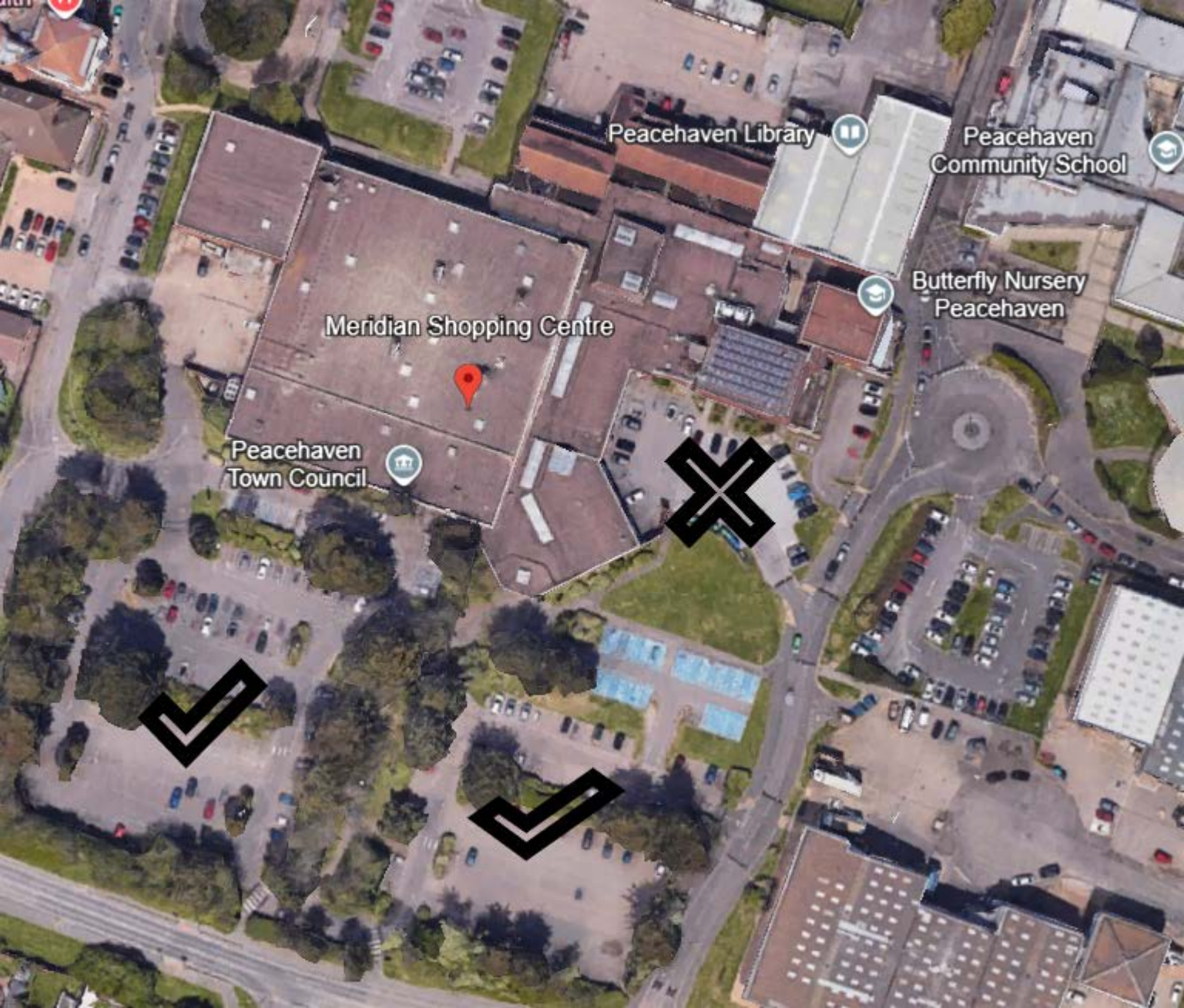

Head Lice Advice

There has been a reported case of head lice which can easily spread with close contact - although they do not pose a serious risk, they can be uncomfortable and require prompt treatment with over the counter products available from pharmacies.

Please check or get your child to check their hair and scalp regularly for any signs of head lice: small white eggs (nits) attached to the hair shaft as well as live lice.

To prevent spreading head lice, encourage your child to avoid sharing personal items such as hats, combs, and hair accessories - regularly wash bedding and clothing in hot water.

Frequently Asked Questions

How many activities can I choose?

You need to be doing an activity every day. When you tick your choices on the Google Form make sure that you have looked at which day it is taking place. There is then the opportunity to try to do similar things with different friends. We can not promise, but we will try to make this happen.

Some activities take place across more than one day, please take care to read the booklet properly so that you can map out your week.

What if there are not enough spaces for what I would like to do?

We will try to make sure everybody can take part in the activities they have chosen. We have indicated how many spaces there are for each activity this year. We do ask that you put 3 reserve choices down in case some activities prove to be very popular.

I would like some financial support with paying for an activity, how do I know if I am eligible and how do I request a reduction?

who will be able to refer you to the appropriate person for advice.

What are the timings of the day?

All of the activities take place during the school day. Exact timings will be shared with you once you have confirmation of your activities.

What will I need to wear?

For all onsite activities, students will be asked to come in in their PE kit.

For all other activities, suggestions will be made once you have confirmation of your activities. (You will not be expected to wear your school uniform!)

What will happen about lunch?

You will have a lunch break as normal if you take part in activities in school.

For those activities off site, we will advise on a packed lunch. For those students in receipt of Free School Meals who are off site, we will provide a packed lunch if required.

Will I need any extra money?

That is your own decision, if you have chosen an activity in Brighton, with bus travel, you will need to pay for travel. If you are in school, you will not need any extra money.

If you have paid for coach travel to an activity, you might wish to bring some money for souvenirs.

When is the deadline to make choices?

The deadline to make choices is **Friday 19th December**
