Syllabus : AQA DT	Students are shown product and material examples from the different scales of production, and discussion in groups. Notes made for each scale, with advantages and disadvantages discussed and noted. Repeatable examples made.
Vocabulary:	Keywords - Scales of production, one-off, batch, mass, continuous production, labour intensive, Just-in-time (JIT), planned obsolescence.
Cultural Capital:	Understanding why different products and materials have different relative costs, and economic benefits of certain materials, processes, and industrial practices (JIT & Kanban). Why and how some products are designed to fail by the manufacture, and the advantages and disadvantages of this.
Key assessments- name the assessments	Adaptive choice - revision cards, books or paper, student choice. Worksheet from the AQA Revision Workbook to test knowledge. AQA exam question from 2021 paper as a worked example. Section A & B exam questions for Planned obsolescence.
