<b>Year group: 8</b>	<b>Subject: Computing</b>
<b>Prior learning- linked to National curriculum</b>	<p>Students have completed the Y7 topic 'Clear messaging in digital media' and will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Create, reuse, revise, and repurpose digital artefacts for a given audience, with attention to trustworthiness, design, and usability</li></ul> <p>Student will have also completed the Y8 topic 'Developing for the Web' and would have experienced creating and designing their own website.</p>
<b>Rationale</b>	<p>In this unit, learners will be introduced to Photopea (online image editing software) and develop their skills using various tools.</p> <p>By the end of the unit, learners will create a digital image for a design brief. We have chosen this engaging topic now as it's a great way to start the year and allows students to get a taste of digital imaging and the Creative iMedia course we run at KS4.</p>
