




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

We have also been impressed with the way the students have returned, taking care to ensure the safety of everyone in school.





When I was taken my photos I was really interested in all the different angles and making it look 3D.




These three photos are my favourite because I really like that all my food is different colours and shapes which adds to the effect of the image, the lighting is good and all the angles look different and make it look 3D.

For the Year 11's, well done for finishing the Controlled Assessment 2 period, you've got a month until the next ones so keep up the hard work.


I hope everyone has a lovely half term and takes as much time as they need to relax and unwind.
