This creative, nurturing and supported visual arts course could be for individuals of any level who want to meet new people, shape the work we do and try a new arts skill. This course will involve a level of group-working activity and individual supported practice. We'll have 6 late-afternoon sessions in the week, alongside 2 half-day Saturday daytime sessions!
