

# How do you find a work experience placement?

- → Speak with family/friends, local businesses to ask if you can do work experience with them. The deadline for this is the **Monday 19th January 2026.**
- → Mrs Lane will be giving usernames and passwords to access the platform Careers East Sussex in your PDI sessions. If you do not receive this then please go to the library at break or lunch and she will give you the details.
- → For any students who have not found their own placement, or are struggling with Careers East Sussex, they will have a meeting with Ms Newman and Ms Lane before February half term 2026 to find a placement.





## How can you get the most from your placement?

Make you placement choice **SMART** to give you the best insight into the World of Work

- S Skills (Develop your employability skills)
- M Make (Make you feel excited at the prospect of going into the workplace)
- A Area (Area of work that you are interested in)
- R Realistic (Consider realistically what you will be able to do in this placement)
- T Transport (The experience of transport and commuting to and from work)
