Reminders for examinations

Every student will need the following items of equipment in order to complete their exams:

- Black ink pen or black biro
- A HB pencil
- An eraser
- A ruler
- A pencil sharpener

In addition to these items, Mathematics and Science exams require:

- A scientific calculator (students are responsible for their own calculators, including replacing batteries and making sure that the calculator is in good working order before their exam)
- A protractor
- A compass

Please also note the following:

- Notes, timetables and revision books must not be taken into the exam venue
- Mobile phones and smart watches **are not permitted** in the exam venue
- Coats, bags and folders must not be taken into the venue
- All equipment **must** be taken into the venue in a transparent container (such as a transparent pencil case or a clear plastic bag)
- A bottle of water can be brought into the venue in a clear bottle but any labels **must** be removed
- Coloured drinks and food **are not permitted**.
